The following information is being provided in response to questions received about the project after the site tour of February 18, 2016.

Question 1: Would it be possible to get a copy of the existing survey for the site?

Answer 1: A topographic survey follows at the end of this document. It is in .pdf format. A CAD file of the survey information will be provided to the person or firm whose proposal is selected.

Question 2: What information is expected for the area of the shelter?

Answer 2: The site development plan should include grading of a level area to accommodate shelter construction, including the slab and adjacent patio as shown on the concept plan. County Parks staff will provide desired grades and maximum allowable road and parking lot slopes to successful proposer prior to project start.

Ouestion 3: Is the restroom heated?

Answer 3: No.

Question 4: What is the anticipated construction schedule desired by the County?

Fall 2016. Answer 4:

Is landscaping required for the site? **Ouestion 5:**

Answer 5: No.

Question 6: Will Dane County contract for a soils investigation report for the septic system or will the consultant be required to include that in our contract?

Answer 6: The successful proposer is responsible for submitting all required permit applications. Dane County will pay the permit fees. A soils investigation is required for septic system design and should not be considered a separate item.

Ouestion 7: Are there any other wells on the property?

Answer 7: No.

Question 8: Does the County intend on needing more than a low-capacity well in the future?

Answer 8: No.

- **Question 9:** Does the County have a preference on the installation of a single or multiple pressure tanks operating with a constant speed submersible pump or a constant-pressure type system with a well pump operating with a VFD and small pressure tank?
- **Answer 9:** The preference is for a constant-pressure system with a well pump operating with a VFD and small pressure tank.
- **Question 10:** Who will be submitting the Dane County erosion control and stormwater management permit applications and fees?
- **Answer 10:** The successful proposer is responsible for submitting all required permit applications. Dane County will pay the permit fees.
- **Question 11:** Will Dane County require soils borings for stormwater infiltration design or will the infiltration rate indicated for the soil management unit be sufficient?
- **Answer 11:** Stormwater infiltration practices should be designed in accordance with Dane County Chapter 14.
- **Question 12:** Is demolition of the existing shelter to be included in the construction documents? **Answer 12:** Yes.




FIGURE NO 1 - TOPEGRAPHIC SITE SURVEY RFP NO 3 15026 ADDENDUM NO. 1
