- F. Alternate #2: Add landscaping as shown.
- G. Optional Alternate #3: Add to base bid for pre-manufactured column cover system equal to “IROC” by Icon Shelter Systems.”

Page 3 - Item 2.01.A

Insert the following:

“4. The following manufactures will be approved provided they meet all provisions of the specification including but not limited to 10-year warranty and column configurations.”

Page 4 - Item 10

Revise to read as follows:

“a. ELECTRICAL ACCESS

- 1) All column bases to have 1-3/4” diameter hole located in the center of the plate to allow electrical wiring into base. Each structure will have power receptacles on (2) columns and (2) light fixtures as shown on electrical drawings. Shelter manufacturer is required to coordinate and accommodate requirements for cut-outs.
- b. Simulated stone base equal to “IROC” by Icon Shelter System at Optional Alternate #3 only.”

Revise current sheet SA1.0 by adding the following:

“Picnic tables – barrier-free wheelchair accessible picnic tables will be 8’ long units (other tables will remain 6’) Model T8INNVROLLHDCP”

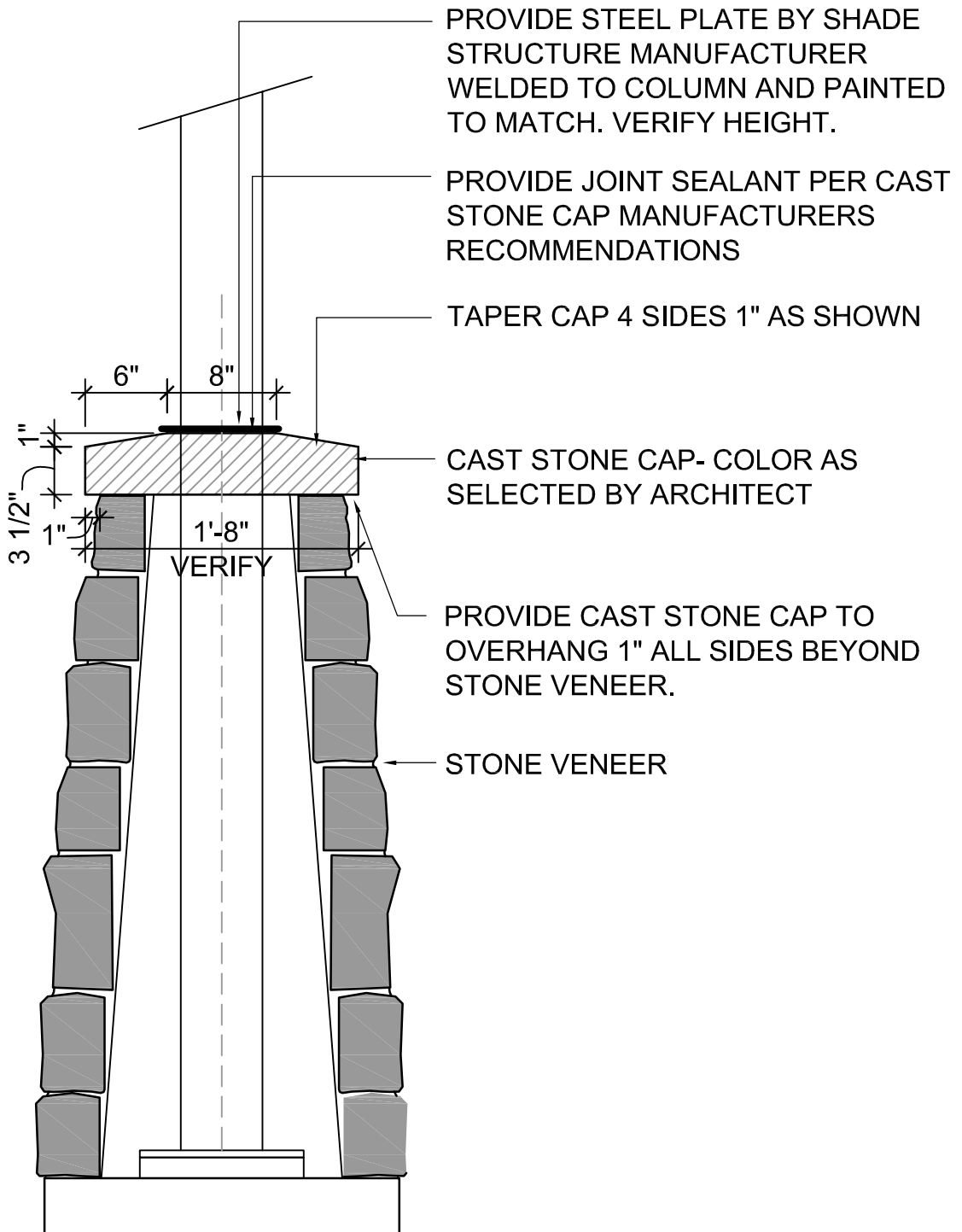
