STEWART LAKE HYDRAULIC DREDGE

BIDS DUE: THURSDAY, JULY 2, 2009, 2:00 PM. DUE DATE AND TIME ARE NOT CHANGED BY THIS ADDENDUM.

This Addendum is issued to modify, explain or clarify the original Request for Bid (RFB) and is hereby made a part of the RFB. Please attach this Addendum to the RFB.

PLEASE MAKE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES:

SCHEDULE "B" BORROW MATERIAL

Dane County has approximately 3000 cu. yds. of previously dredged Stewart Lake shoreline material at the South entrance to the park. This is available for immediate inspection.

The successful bidder, if bidding Schedule "B" which involves using the two lower dewatering sites, may use this material for site leveling and berm building. There would be no cost to the Contractor for this material. If the successful bidder chooses not to use this material or only part of it, the balance will be removed by the Owner starting on July 8th and be finished by August 1st.

Contractors are to be aware that if they reserve too much material, they are responsible for its removal. This would be necessary because it diminishes the site capacity and would require higher geotextile tube stacking. If Contractors do not reserve enough material they would have to haul in borrow at their own expense.

PERFORMANCE/PAYMENT BOND

The 100% performance and payment bond should be issued as a combination bond for the total amount of the construction costs (100%). If a bonding company wants to issue separate bonds, Dane County would still need to be covered for 100% of construction costs for performance and for payment.

CRANE ACCESS ON DAM

Cranes and backhoes may use the top flat area of the dam berm for loading or unloading equipment. The responsibility for any immediate damage or any deterioration that may occur within three months from this activity, will be that of the Contractor. Repairs will have to be made within 2 days of damage. It is not permissible to use the dam side slopes or any area within 50' of the concrete dam structure. Crane mats will be necessary to distribute weight and prevent any concentrated point loading.

TAXES

The County does not pay any sales tax. However, the Contractor is responsible for any tax on materials used on the project.
