This Addendum is issued to modify, explain or clarify the original Request for Bid (RFB) and is hereby made a part of the RFB. Please attach this Addendum to the RFB.

PLEASE MAKE THE FOLLOWING CHANGES:

1. Section 00 41 13 - Bid Form

Delete current Bid Form; replace with new Bid Form, issued with this Addendum.

2. Sheet 3 – Site Plan

Delete current Sheet 3 (Site Plan); replace with new Sheet 3 (Site Plan), issued with this Addendum. Scrape #7 has been eliminated.

3. Sheet 4 - Scrapes

Delete current Sheet 4 (Scrapes); replace with new Sheet 4 (Scrapes), issued with this Addendum. Scrape #7 has been removed.

4. Sheet 6 – Embankment & Spillway Details

Modify current Sheet 6 as follows: in NOTES for the spillway:

NOTES:

- 1) Change Note 1 to read: "Erosion Control Blanket shall be Class I, Type B URBAN, Double Netting.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CONTRACTOR SUBMITTED QUESTIONS:

Q1: Is it possible to label the scrapes location on sheet 3 to correspond with the scrape numbers, area, and CY on sheet 4?

A1: Changed on revised plan Sheet 3.

Q2: What is the completion date?

A2: October 1 is preferred Date may be extended if weather conditions do not allow contractor to get on site in a timely manner.

- Q3: Is Ducks Unlimited or Dane county going to supply a TIN for grade control, and survey?
A3: DU will supply an .xml file for machine grading with 5 control points.
- Q4: Who will be responsible for as-built?
A4: DU will be responsible to complete as-built plan and record drawings.
- Q5: Is there a need for compaction (proctor) tests? Who is responsible for, if needed?
A5: Compaction tests will not be required on project. DU technician on site will verify compaction on site by placement of fill in lifts with dozer.
- Q6: Who is responsible for obtaining Local, State, and Federal permits?
A6: USFWS / Dane County Parks will secure all necessary permits.
- Q7: Is there going to be a need of silt fence around the project? And quantity anticipated?
A7: The plan is to leave the existing ditch banks undisturbed so the existing bank will remain covered with grass. The only runoff would come off the back slope of embankment which is a very short area. That area will also be seeded and mulched to protect from erosion.
- Q8: May I complete a site inspection with an ATV/UTV or other motorized vehicle?
A8: Contractors may request permission to complete a site inspection using an ATV/UTV through Joleen Stinson, Interim Parks Director at 608-422-0657 or stinson.joleen@countyofdane.com. The request must be made 24 business hours before the planned site visit and confirmation must be received before bringing equipment on site. ATV/UTV to be kept to the perimeter of the work area as much as possible. Dane County Parks is not responsible if equipment gets stuck or damaged during the inspection process.



DANE COUNTY VENDOR REGISTRATION PROGRAM



TYPICAL WETLAND SCRAPE CROSS SECTION

Notes:

1. Scrapes/borrow areas will be constructed at locations and as flagged by the technician.
2. Scrapes are to be irregular in shape when completed. Wheel ruts are allowed and desired.
3. Strip minimum 6" of topsoil and stockpile it for spreading, if needed, after the excavation is completed.
4. Spoil shall be used for embankment and ditch fills.
